


THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR STATE BOARD OF SCHOOL EDUCATION, JAMMU

NOTIFICATION

It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that:-

- i) the admission of successful candidates of Secondary School Examination (Class X) Private April, Session 2010 whose result has been declared on 20-06-2010 to the Higher Secondary Part-I Course (Class XI) in the recognized (Govt. / Pvt) Higher Secondary Schools of Jammu Province will be completed by 20-07-2010 without payment of any late fee.
- ii) no one shall be admitted in any recognized Higher Secondary Schools after 20-07-2010 provided that a late fee of Rs. 140/- shall be charged from each candidate seeking late admission upto and including 30-07-2010.
- iii) the regular teaching work of the Class-XI shall start immediately after the expiry of the last date of admission. (without late fee).
- iv) the attendance of all the candidates admitted under S.No. (i) and (ii) above shall be calculated from the date of teaching work of the class starts.
- v) candidates of Secondary School Examination (Class X) conducted by J&K State Board of School Education as are placed in re-appear category in any one subject only are eligible for admission to Higher Secondary Examination Par-I (Class XI) but the result of such candidate/s shall remain withheld, unless they clear the fifth subject of the Secondary School Examination (Class-X).
- vi) no one shall be admitted to Higher Secondary Examination Part-I (Class-XI) either as regular or private candidate who has failed in one or more than one subject of Secondary School Examination (Class-X) conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi or by any other examining body established by Law in India in force for the time being outside the J&K State.
- vii) No candidate seeking interschool migration shall be admitted by any Head of the institution even provisionally under any circumstances before his / her (candidate's) Inter-school migration is sanctioned by the Board. The erring institution shall be personally responsible for the consequences for granting un-authorized admission to the students and the Board shall incur no liability / responsibility on this account.
- viii) There is no need of migration school to school from High School to Hr. Sec. School falling under their nearby catchment area even if involve inter district.
- ix) the Heads of the institutions are required to pay the prescribed examination fee Rs. 170/- per candidate in the Board chest alongwith subject wise statement and stream wise enrollment by 10-08-2010
